Denpasar Full Day City Tour followed by Tanah Lot Temple Tour

Bajra Sandhi:

It is a beautiful monument to commemorate the Balinese struggle against the Dutch colonialism that is replicated in a beautiful and artistic building design by Balinese architectures in form of Bajra (Bell). It is located in the center of Denpasar city right in front of Bali's governor office situated in Renon village.

Bali Museum:


It is one of famous Places to visit in Denpasar city with a collection of the ancient objects related to the history of Bali Island generally. This Museum is strategically located on Mayor Wisnu Street, just beside of Jagatnatha Temple or in front of Puputan Badung Square Garden.

Puputan Square:

It is an attractive open square located in the city center. This classic urban park draws many locals and is a great place to learn about Bali's colonial history. You'll find a monument depicting a heroic Balinese family in the square, which commemorates the suicidal battle of the rajas of Badung against the invading Dutch militia in 1906.

Tanah Lot Sea Temple:

One of Bali's most photographed location. Perched atop an enormous rock, the temple is completely surrounded by the waters of the Indian Ocean.

Dolphin Watching at Lovina Beach, Gitgit Waterfall followed by Ulun Danu Beratan and Taman Ayun Temple

Lovina Beach is the most famous beach in north part of Bali offering beautiful panoramic view with coconut trees planted along the coastal area that make it as the ideal place to stay and use traditional outrigger boat to see Dolphin in the middle of sea. Hundreds of dolphins can be seen in the morning time around 1 km offshore.

Git Git Waterfall is an amazing waterfall which is encircled by fertile rain forest plantation. We will visit this waterfall after Watching Dolphin at Lovina beach. This Waterfall is situated in the forest, with a fresh atmosphere.

The Ulun Danu Beratan temple is a famous pictureque landmark and a significant temple located on the western side of Beratan Lake in Bedugul, central Bali. Ulun Danu literally translates to 'the source temple of Lake Beratan'.

Taman Ayun Temple is a landmark in the village of Mengwi, Badung regency, located 17km northwest of Denpasar. This temple complex boasts magnificent traditional architectural features throughout its courtyards as well as expansive garden landscapes comprised of lotus and fish ponds.
